SHOW CAUSE ORDER


The deadline for receiving the parties' prehearing statements was March 12, 2010. Four parties failed to file their prehearing statements: Denver Water, Wellington Water Works, LLC, Lyntek, Inc., and Patsy Moran. These four parties are ordered to show cause why they did not comply with the prehearing statement requirements. Failure to respond to this Show Cause Order may result in the loss of party status or limited participation in the rulemaking hearing. Please refer to the Notice of Public Rulemaking Hearing (the Notice) for a description of what to include in the prehearing statement and for the specific filing requirements.

Denver Water, Wellington Water Works, LLC, Lyntek, Inc., and Patsy Moran are ordered to respond to this Show Cause Order by March 19, 2010. The response should include the parties' reasons for not timely filing a prehearing statement and their prehearing statement. The response must be filed and served as described in the Notice.

REBUTTAL AND RESPONSE DEADLINE EXTENSION

Multiple parties failed to strictly comply with the filing and service requirements listed in the Notice. To ensure that all the parties have adequate time to respond, and in anticipation of any additional prehearing statements being received on March 19, 2010, the deadline for rebuttal statements is extended to March 29, 2010. This deadline extension includes responses to prehearing motions as described in the Notice. Parties must file and serve, as described in the Notice, rebuttal statements and any responses by March 29, 2010.


