As required by Rule 2 (10) of the Regulations of the Mine Safety & Training Program (MSTP) for Tourist Mines, 2 C.C.R. 407-6, each tourist mine owner/operator shall submit to the Mine Safety Program a preseason report, including a plan map indicating any changes from the previous year's areal map, and describing any changes in tourist routes or any other changes in operating conditions such as new or modified escape routes, mine ventilation, or barricaded areas.

Include a plan map indicating any changes from the previous year's area map.
