REQUEST FOR TRANSFER OF NOTICE OF INTENT
TO CONDUCT COAL EXPLORATION
AND SUCCESSION OF PERSONS CONDUCTING COAL EXPLORATION

I.

RECITALS

- A. On _____, _____, the Mined Land Reclamation Board of the Colorado Department of Natural Resources (the "State") granted to _____, address _____ "Person to Conduct Coal Exploration" ("Person") file number _____ (the "Notice of Intent") pursuant to which Person has been conducting an exploration and reclamation operation in the County of _____, State of Colorado.
- B. Person wishes to assign the Notice of Intent to _____, address _____, as Successor Person ("Successor") and Successor wishes to become Successor under the Notice of Intent.
- C. Successor understands that the reclamation permit (the "Plan") required by the Notice of Intent and by applicable State laws and regulations has not been completed and is willing to assume full responsibility for the completion of the Plan.

II.

AGREEMENTS

Person and Successor hereby agree, for their own benefit and for the benefit of the State, such agreements to be effective ipso facto upon the approval by the State of the transfer of the Notice of Intent from Person to Successor, as follows:

- 1. Successor has inspected the exploration and reclamation operations to its entire satisfaction and is fully aware of the condition thereof. Successor understands and accepts all of the conditions of the approval of the Notice of Intent.
- 2. Successor will complete the reclamation plan, and hereby assumes liability for completing such plan as to all areas heretofore disturbed, as well as to all areas hereafter disturbed. Successor will perform all of the obligations of the Person under the Notice of Intent which have not heretofore been performed by Person.
- 3. Successor hereby tenders to the State its attached reclamation bond*, which is to be substituted for the bond and surety heretofore filed by the Person effective upon the release of the latter bond and surety.

4. Successor represents to the State that, to the best of its knowledge, information and belief, it is not in violation of any of the provisions of the Colorado Surface Coal Mining Reclamation Act with respect to any other operation conducted by it in the State of Colorado.

Person and Successor hereby request the State to consent to the assignment of the Notice of Intent, to recognize Successor as Successor Person under the Notice of Intent, and to accept the tendered substitute bond and surety in place of bond and surety presently on file with the State.
