INSTRUCTIONS

If, as a party, you will not be able to attend a Pre-hearing Conference or Board hearing, you may designate another person, such as a consultant, to represent your interests. However, in order for the Pre-hearing Conference Officer or Board to recognize your representative, *you must complete the attached form*. The form must include your notarized signature. For items that do not apply, please write N/A in the blank space.

Your representative must present the original notarized form to the Pre-hearing Conference Officer or Board at the time of the hearing.
